- **4.** Entries will be judged based on the following criteria: how well the design represents this year's Peanut Festival theme (shown above) and its effectiveness for marketing and production.
- 5. Entries must be submitted no later than <u>11:59 p.m.</u> **DEADLINE EXTENDED TO MAY 16, 2025**
- **6.** Entry must be your original concept. Hand drawing and all computer submissions must be original in thought and match this year's theme.
- **7.** Designs must be submitted with the artist's name and contact information. If under 18, must include the guardian's contact information and permission to enter their submission.
- 8. There are two ways to submit entries:

- 9. The winning entry will receive:
